

Instructional Delivery of Erin's Law during School Closure

The State requires instruction in sexual abuse and assault awareness and prevention, with separate units appropriate for each age level from four-year kindergarten through twelfth-grade, which is often referred to as Erin's Law. We were not able to provide this instruction prior to the school closure.
