

Criteria for applying for an appeal: If you are passing your subjects but have lost credit due to absences you may ask that your loss of credit be reviewed at the end of the each semester IF your absences are due to extreme hardship or extenuating circumstances. PLEASE NOTE: In order to appeal, you must NOT have excessive absences; NOT have any non-medical absences after you have been notified of your loss of credit; NOT have cut class or left school grounds without permission; and have made every effort possible to regain your credit prior to appeal.
