General Information 2021-2022

Three steps are required prior to beginning instruction:

1. Getting Registered

- Complete registration online or in-person
- Provide school withdrawal form and official transcript. (Note: Only for High School Diploma students and/or students under age 22)
- Take Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE) Test. (Note: Assessment scores determine initial placement in GED instruction.)

2. Making Payment

- Pay \$35 online, cash, or check (Note: Online payment is \$37 because of a bank-service fee.)

3. Getting Oriented

- Complete orientation related to program information, and career counseling
